Guaranteed Departure (06 Nights / 07 Days) – 2026/27 | With guide

Day 1 – Arrival in Muscat

Arrival at Muscat International Airport, meet-and-greet with our representative, and transfer to the hotel for check-in.

In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of Muscat: the **Royal Opera House**, an elegant example of modern Omani architecture; the traditional **Muttrah Souq**, one of the oldest markets in the country, filled with spices, frankincense, textiles, and silver jewelry; and finally, a photo stop at **Al Alam Palace**, the ceremonial residence of the Sultan, flanked by the Portuguese forts of Jalali and Mirani.

Overnight stay in Muscat.

Day 2 – Muscat – Grand Mosque – Bimah Sinkhole – Wadi Shab – Muscat

After breakfast, visit the **Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque**, one of the most impressive in the Middle East. Admire the elegant marble architecture, the prayer hall featuring the world's second-largest handmade Persian carpet, and the majestic Swarovski crystal chandelier.

Please note: Modest dress is required; women must cover their head, shoulders, and knees.

Continue toward the coast with a stop at **Bimah Sinkhole**, a spectacular limestone depression filled with emerald-green waters. Next, visit **Wadi Shab**, one of Oman's most scenic canyons. After a short boat ride and a walk through the gorge, you will reach natural turquoise pools, small waterfalls, and lush banana and papaya orchards. You will have the opportunity to swim in the crystal-clear waters.

Return to Muscat in the evening.

Overnight stay in Muscat.

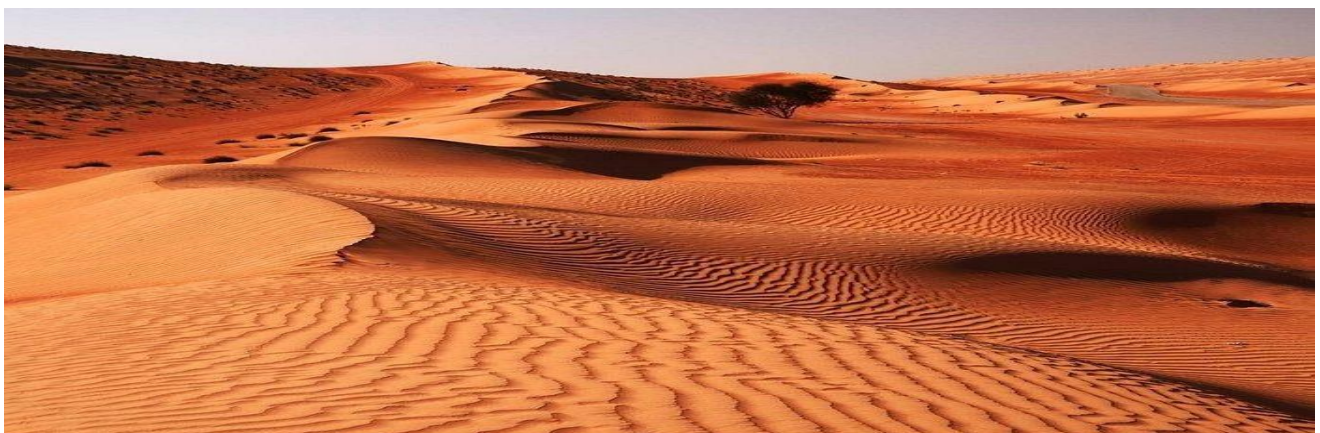
Meals: Breakfast – Picnic Lunch – Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 – Dimanayat Islands Excursion & Muscat City Tour

In the morning, take an excursion to the **Dimanayat Islands**, a protected nature reserve renowned for its pristine beaches and coral-rich waters. Enjoy snorkeling among tropical fish and, with a bit of luck, spotting sea turtles or dolphins. Return around 13:30.

Overnight stay in Muscat.

Meals: Breakfast – Packed Lunch.



Day 4 – Muscat – Amouage Perfume Factory – Wadi Bani Khalid – Wahiba Sands

After breakfast, visit the prestigious **Amouage perfume factory**, famous for its luxury fragrances created using rare ingredients like frankincense, rose, and myrrh.

Continue to **Wadi Bani Khalid**, a verdant oasis framed by date palms and turquoise natural pools, perfect for a refreshing swim.

Lunch at a local restaurant.

Depart for the **Wahiba Sands** desert, a vast sea of golden dunes rising over 100 meters high, home to the Bedouins for millennia. Enjoy a thrilling 4x4 drive through the dunes and arrive at Al Salam Camp in the heart of the desert. Spend the evening under a starry sky in a unique atmosphere.

Overnight stay in Wahiba Sands (Al Salam Camp)

Meals: Breakfast – Lunch at a restaurant – Dinner.



Day 5 – Wahiba Sands – Jabrin – Bahla – Nizwa

After breakfast, depart for **Jabrin Castle**, a refined 17th-century fortress celebrated for its painted ceilings, calligraphic decorations, and harmonious architecture.

Take a photo stop at **Bahla**, a UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for its massive mud-brick fortress and ancient city walls.

Arrive in **Nizwa**, the ancient capital and the "Pearl of Islam". Visit its traditional souq, famous for khanjars (traditional daggers), silver jewelry, and local handicrafts.

Overnight stay in Nizwa.

Meals: Breakfast – Dinner at the hotel.

Day 6 – Nizwa – Birkat al Mouz – Jebel Akhdar – Muscat

After breakfast, continue to **Birkat al Mouz**, a charming historical village at the foot of the mountains, famous for its impressive irrigation channels (falaj) and the ruins of an ancient palace. The village offers an authentic glimpse into traditional rural Omani life, surrounded by lush date palm plantations.

Ascend **Jebel Akhdar** (the "Green Mountain"), one of Oman's highest peaks at over 2,000 meters above sea level. Famous for its terraced fields growing roses, pomegranates, and apricots, it offers breathtaking views of the surrounding gorges, canyons, and traditional villages clinging to the cliffs.

Overnight stay in Muscat.

Day 7 – Departure from Muscat

Meals: Breakfast – Dinner at the hotel.
